Where is the new library being built?

The new building site is adjacent to the southeast end of the Firstenburg Community Center at 700 NE 136th Ave., on the west side of the street between SE Mill Plain Blvd. and NE 9th St.



The new site is about one mile northwest of the current library on Hearthwood Blvd.

Where are we in the building process?

We are **nearing completion of the construction document phase** after getting a go-ahead on the building design from the Clark County Commissioners, who serve as the Vancouver Library Capital Facility Area board. We are selecting furniture, floor coverings, shelving and sign systems.

What's next?

1. Completing construction documents
2. Applying for building permits
3. Pre-qualifying potential general contractors
4. Planning a public groundbreaking event to be held at the site in May
