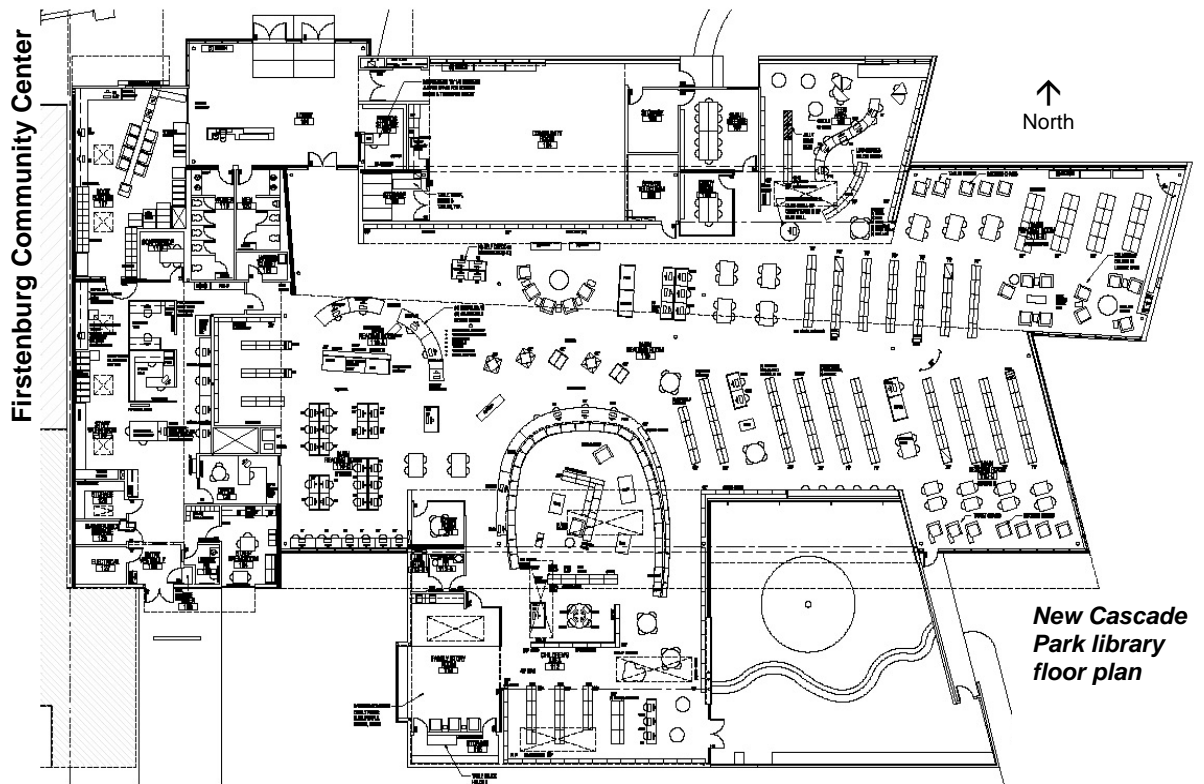

About the new library building

Location: Adjacent to the southeast end of Firstenberg Community Center. Address is 600 NE 136th Ave., Vancouver WA 98684.

Construction start: Sept. 2008

Architects: Opsi Architecture, Portland, and Johnston Architects, Seattle

General contractor: Union Corner Construction, Vancouver

Size: Approx. 24,000 square feet

Cost of project: Total of approximately \$10.2 million, funded by a 2006 library bond measure approved by Vancouver voters. Land for the library building was provided by the City of Vancouver.

Hours will be: Tu W Th 9-8; F Sat 9-6
