The Fall Writing Contest is open to teens in **grades 6-12** who live within,
attend school, or are homeschooled in the Fort Vancouver Regional Library
District and the Woodland School District.

Entries must be 1,000 words or less. They may be typed or clearly
handwritten in black ink, and must be in English. Entries may be faxed,
turned in on paper to any FVRL library, or emailed as an attachment to
teens@fvrl.org. Entries will be accepted until closing on **Friday, October 2**.

The **format is open** to many types of writing including, but not limited
to: short stories, poetry, comic strips and more. Just remember: this is a
WRITING contest, and the judging focus will be on your words. **All genres**
of writing are encouraged (i.e. Horror, Science Fiction, Romance, Western,
Fantasy and more!)

Entries will be read by a panel of judges. **Prizes** will be awarded to
winners in two age groups (6-8th grade & 9-12th grade). Winners will be
announced at a party on Friday, October 23. Stories will also be published
on the library's teen website (www.fvrl.org/teens). Stories may be edited
for spelling and grammar.
