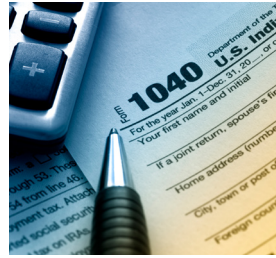


BOOK DISCUSSION KITS FOR CHECKOUT
