USING YOUR LIBRARY CARD

Borrowing items

- Your FVRL card can be used at any FVRL library or bookmobile, online at www.fvrl.org, and at Camas Public Library.
- See the chart below for information about borrowing periods and holds limits.
- You can request materials for pickup at any library location by using the Place Hold feature in the library catalog.

Renewing items

- Most items may be renewed, provided no one else has requested them.
- You can renew most checked-out items on or before the due date, in person or by using My Account at www.fvrl.org, or by calling 360-750-9999 (toll-free 800-750-9876 from area code 509).

Returning items

- You can return physical items to any FVRL location or to the Camas library. Most libraries have 24/7 book-return slots.
- Most returned items are checked back in and removed from your account the day that you return them.

Notices (for physical items)

- You will receive pick-up notices by email, phone or U.S. mail when requested materials are available at the library you selected.
- You will receive courtesy notices by email when items are due soon.
- The library sends overdue notices at one week and two weeks overdue, by email, phone or U.S. mail.
- Bills for replacement charges will be sent by U.S. mail or email when items are four weeks overdue.

Your responsibilities

- Be responsible for any item that anyone checks out using your card number.
- Return or renew checked-out materials on or before the due date.
- Let us know promptly of any changes in your address or other contact information.
- Report lost or stolen library cards to us at once.
- Promptly pay any fees accrued on your account.

Fees

- FVRL does not charge late fines for overdue items.
- However, if an item is overdue for 28 days or more it is considered 'lost' and we will bill you for the replacement cost.
- Returning a 'lost' item in good condition will remove the bill for that

item from your account.

- Accounts with charges of \$40 or more will be referred to a collection agency 30 days after billing. At that time, a non-refundable, \$10 fee will be added to the bill.

Loss of privileges

Your library card privileges will be blocked if you owe \$25 or more for items billed as lost or damaged.

Restoration of privileges

For an account in collections:

Resolve the entire account balance down to \$0.

For a blocked account:

Resolve your account balance to under \$25, either through payment or return of billed materials.

For an account blocked by interlibrary loan (ILL) bills:

Resolve the entire amount charged by the lending library.
